### REPEAL OF PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION IN THE MATTER CONCRETE CANVAS AGAINST EUROBENT BECOMES FINAL - EUROBENT FREE OF RESTRICTIONS TO SELL TILTEX AND TILTEX PLUS

In its press release of 29 July 2022, Eurobent Sp. z o.o. reported the repeal of the preliminary injunction granted to Concrete Canvas Ltd in 2018, which prohibited Eurobent Sp. z o.o. from manufacturing and placing on the market of certain goods, potentially infringing that patent. Such preliminary injunction was (incorrectly) interpreted in the past as applicable to the “Tiltex” and “Tiltex Plus” products. In its decision of 21 July 2022, the Court sided with Eurobent and struck that injunction down, taking into account that after the judgement of 9 May 2022, dismissing claims of Concrete Canvas in the first instance, they can no longer be considered probable and therefore do not merit being secured by a preliminary measure.

That decision has not been appealed by Concrete Canvas and is now final. This has resulted in the elimination of all judicial barriers against Eurobent’s manufacturing and selling its products, including “Tiltex” and “Tiltex Plus”. Now there can be no grounds whatsoever to claim that sales of “Tiltex” or “Tiltex Plus” breach any court decision, as no decisions shall remain in force that could be interpreted as applicable to Eurobent’s products.

The decision of the Regional Court in Legnica of 21 July 2022 is the most recent in the chain of events which validate Eurobent’s position consistently presented throughout the dispute with Concrete Canvas, that “Tiltex” and “Tiltex Plus” do not infringe intellectual property of Concrete Canvas or any other party, but are advanced products created by Eurobent Sp. z o.o. in full compliance with law, which can be legitimately manufactured and traded in Poland, as well as in other countries of the World.
